The University Staff Excellence Awards (USEA) program was established in 1992 to recognize superior service and ongoing contributions by the University of Utah's full-time staff employees. In 2006, the process was changed to allow recognition of the exceptional contribution of a much larger number of staff. In 2023, a new award category was introduced to recognize the outstanding efforts of our part-time staff employees (.01 to .74 FTE). Twenty-four District Staff Excellence Awards (DSEA) are given to staff from four Districts, and four Part-Time Awards will be given (one per District). The number of awards for each District is determined by the number of staff working in that area.

October 2nd: Walk After Dark


The Annual University of Utah Walk After Dark event brings together campus organizations such as Environmental Health and Safety, ASUU, Facilities Management, Public Safety, and others to conduct a survey of lighting levels and other safety related issues across campus. During the event cross functional teams composed of individuals from various organizations walk every sidewalk on campus to survey lighting levels and look for safety issues related to travel across campus at night. Any issues identified are reported to University Facility Operations for corrective action.
